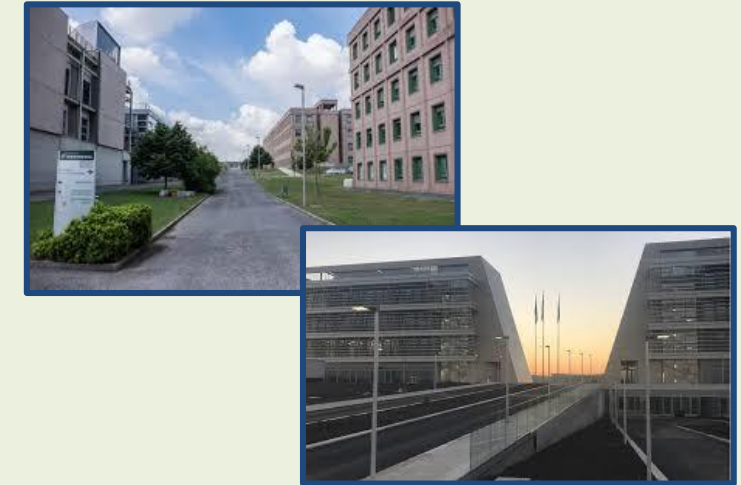
- The built environment (Passive and Active Building Design);
